Plate labeled "CB BP X001" has two small fragments. The upper fragment is Bodmer Papyrus VI. The bottom fragment is Bodmer Papyrus XX, which was part of the Bodmer Codex that contained P72 and other biblical writings. The text is from the *Apology of Phileas*, also known as the *Acts of Phileas*. There are also two tiny fragments, c. 1 mm and 2 mm wide, in the right side (middle) of the glass that are from P66, which was originally in this plate as well.²
