GA 1149, beautiful petite hand. Something like 4 point type! Definitely parchment, not paper (even though the catalog says parchment, but was corrected to paper). Supposed to be a Psalter and NT. Several letters in gold. A few replacement pages, but obvious because they are in black ink (though equally beautiful).

All "alleluiahs" in Psalms are in gold letters, although this cannot easily be distinguished.

20x14 to 20x13.5, 30 st., 1 col.

paginated: accurately!

three prefatory pages (for shots), plus one binding page at end, plus covers. 467 files per side. shooter is plus 4.

NT starts on leaf 102a, file 106a.
