Thus: 214a = ‘212a.’ Even though the quotation marks are used, there is no ‘a’ on the written page. For a MS that is paginated, the *actual leaf* number is listed first, followed by =, followed by the *page number* in quotes. Thus: 214a = ‘423.’
