The MS has the following text:

Matt 1.13–28.17; Mark 1.13–16.20; Luke 1.1–4.20; 6.43–23.47; John 1.1–19.21.

The previous owner was the Monastery of St. John the Baptist in Serres, Macedonia, Northern Greece. In 1917 Bulgarians took the MS to their country; it was returned, with many others, in 1924. The best hypothesis is that the MS was rebound when it was either in Bulgarian hands or before it was in the monastery, since the leaves are out of order in such a way that no Greek would have made such a mistake.
