Additional matter: 2 images

Front cover: 0 additional leaves + cover b = 1 image

Back cover: 0 additional leaves + cover a = 1 image

Spine, Cover, and Color Chart: 7 images (color chart on 1a)

Text: 195 leaves (390 images)

UV (MS pages, not ours): all (392 images)

Specific Details:

Wood boards covered with embossed leather, still largely intact. One male pin still intact. Leather foundations inside back cover also intact, but no female strap.

Paper is very fragile and worm eaten; it may be best not to handle this MS again but to rely on the images only. Extensive mold in the early leaves.

MS is lacking the beginning leaves. Very faint rubrication on many leaves, requiring a lot of UV images.

1a–54b: Acts 1.16b–end

10a–88b: second scribe's hand. This scribe does not use distinct paragraph breaks, just as the last one did not. The entire text for each NT book is one paragraph. However, the scribe does use enlarged rubricated initial letters for each short pericope. The red lettering has faded very badly.

55ab: lection abbreviations

56a–57a: hypothesis for Paul's letters

57b–74b: Romans

62a: εχωμεν in Rom 5.1.

68a: marginal note in black, later ink.

75a: hypothesis for 1 Corinthians

75b–91b: 1 Corinthians

75b: the *beginning* of the Greek alphabet in a child's hand

89a–98b: third scribe, different quality of paper, too (glossier, in better shape).

91b: *subscriptio* at end of 1 Corinthians: του αγιου αποστολου Παυλου επιστολ. προς κορινθ α'. εγραφη απο φιλιππ. τ.ς μακεδονιας. ...

91b: *hypothesis* for 2 Corinthians

91b–102a: 2 Corinthians

99a–186a: second scribe's hand again

102ab: *hypothesis* for Galatians

102b–108a: Galatians

108ab: *hypothesis* for Ephesians

108b–114b: Ephesians

114b–115a: *hypothesis* for Philippians
