**Other notable features:**

MS is trapezoidal; images will not look entirely straight.  
A few corrections are in the margins. Ekthesis with rubricated initial. Eusebian  
canons in margins, rubricated (very faint). Wax drippings on several pages, indicating

much use. Pencil numbering was done after this quire was removed from its whole manuscript.

Luke 9.32 (1r) has an asterisk in the margin (it looks like a tilde with dot above and below, close to a division symbol), though the reason for it is unknown. The text is standard, no variations.

1r: fourth line from bottom: Luke 9.36: εὐρέθη ὁ Ἰησοῦς μόνος, καὶ αὐτοὶ ἐσίγησαν, καὶ οὐδενὶ—the scribe accidentally left out καὶ αὐτοὶ ἐσίγησαν and picked up with the second καὶ. Looks like same hand for correction.

1v: Luke 9.38: has an asterisk in the margin (it looks like a tilde with dot above and below, close to a division symbol), though the reason for it is unknown.

7r: marginal note, fifth line from bottom:

π Γ : (three dots, not two, in margin—may be referring to note in margin a bit higher up)

8r: has an asterisk in the margin (it looks like a tilde with dot above and below, close to a division symbol—this one looks a little different). Luke 11.19: δια τουτο αυτοι κριται υμων, but this seems to be a transposition for either αὐτοὶ ὑμῶν κριταὶ or διὰ τοῦτο κριταὶ ὑμῶν αὐτοὶ. However, it is read in A C K L W Θ Ψ <sup>f<sup>1.13</sup></sup> 33. 892. 1241. 2542 *pm* *aur* *vg*.
