 $^{^{1}}$ Paleographical notes: Many letters fit the pattern of $10^{th}\!\!-\!\!11^{th}$ century MSS (which are not typically found later): ϵ (some forms), $\zeta, \nu, \rho.$ But other letters seem to fall into the 12th–14th centuries: ϵ (some forms), $\iota, \kappa, \tau.$ Date is XII/XIII.

Specific Details:

MS donated to Byzantine Museum.

Extensive provenance and descriptive information on MS from Mr. Kolitsaras, available at museum. The cover letter is dated to December 1941. The manuscript came from Spiros Vlachos, archbishop of Athens. He donated the collection between 1944 and 1950.

Silver embossed covers, over cloth-covered wood boards; with four chains for spine.

75a: rubricated heading for Mark
