Page Count: 360. Each page is numbered, but an icon leaf is loose and placed in the front of the MS. First icon is upside down, and the recto leaf is also upside down. This leaf seems to be from a different manuscript (at least a different hand). We are photographing it as it is inserted in the MS, but both sides need to be turned right side up. Several missing pages and wrong counts. 1-32 is OK (except that we also count the icon leaf, making the total 34). Missing are 33–36, 47–48, 103–108, 219–230. 277 *bis*. 313 is missing. 321-22 is single column, different hand. After 322, the pagination changes to 333 (so 322-332 is missing). 344 is unnumbered (partial leaf; next leaf gets “344”). 347 has lengthy marginal note. 361 is missing. 379 is missing. Goes through 390.

UV: 278 (first one—line erased); the back of the first (loose leaf) icon.

Interesting or significant material: Fragile manuscript; high f-stop needed to photograph. Trapezoidal shape; outside margin of book is smaller. Page “171” starts Luke. Page “321” starts John. Page “282” is folded over on itself. Nothing we can do about it without damaging the leaf.
