Specific Details:

Severe water damage in front of MS: cover is warped and 1a (title page for Mt) is especially damaged.

Wood boards covered with embossed leather, still intact. One male pin still intact on back cover.

OT quotations marked by double squiggly lines in margin. See 133a, 136a.

78a: ornate headpiece for Mark
122a: LE starts here. Abbreviation in margin: ἐω^θ γ, indicating the Third Eothinon (ἐωθινὸν γ), a special chant/hymn sung during Orthros services.

125a-206a: Luke
206b: κεφάλαια for John
207a-267b: John
207a: ornate headpiece for John
