Specific Details:

Embossed leather covers, still intact but spine is frayed. Miniature MS. See Jeff Cate, “Sisters Separated from Birth: An Examination of 792 and 2643 as Private Miniature Manuscripts” (unpublished paper). MS was a gift from Demetrius Bernardos (mentioned on first front cover leaf a).

SN on spine and inside front cover. Also on inside front cover: “ΘΕΟΛ. 67M.”

Letters average c. 1–1.25 mm high, except for those that go above or below the notional line. The letters are so small that they could not be written elegantly. It is difficult to distinguish the difference between a breathing and an accent, for example. The hand seems much less elegant than that of GA 2364 (the ‘wee beastie’). It also is much more compressed. The parchment leaves are significantly thicker in 792. In 2364 they are so thin that each is essentially a stencil, with the ink having eaten through the vellum.

2a–4b: something akin to the Eusebian canons is found here. The Gospel names are found, and the text is written as a list of six columns per page.

5ab: κεφάλαια for Matthew, rubricated

6a–37a: Matthew

6a: Title for Matthew is rubricated; title is το κατα Μαθθαιον αγιον Ευα.

37a: *subscriptio* for Matthew: “the Gospel according to Matthew was published eight years after the”⁵

37ab: κεφάλαια for Mark, rubricated

38a–57a: Mark

38a: Title for Mark is rubricated; title is το κατ Μαρκ. αγιον Ευα.

38a: Mark 1.2 has τοις προφητες, but this MS could hardly have been produced by hearing. See Cate for discussion of the twin sisters.

56b: Mark 16.8, followed by LE

57b: κεφάλαια for Luke, rubricated

58a–87a: Luke⁶

58a: Title for Luke is rubricated; title is το κατα Λουκαν αγιον Ευα.

87a: No *subscriptio* for Luke

87a: κεφ[αλαι]ε [*sic*] for John begin here.

87a: only 11 κεφάλαια for John; PA not mentioned, as is typical even of MSS that have

87b–113b: John

87b: Title for John: εκ του κατ. Ιω. Ευα.—This is the title that a scribe would use for a lection *from* John—one evidence that a new scribe is now at work on this MS. This is also quite evident in the letter formations, elegance, compactness, and style. The first scribe wrote in a no-nonsense style, while this scribe uses more flair.

97a: Εν δε τη εσχατη ημερα τη μεγαλη της εορτης in John 7.37 is changed to εν δε τη εσχατη ημερα της εορτης.
