Specific Details:

Thin embossed modern leather covers, with medieval back cover (over wood boards) largely intact including two studs and leather-work.

Commentary MS with biblical text rubricated, commentary in black and otherwise not separated. Αρχη and τέλος are found in black at beginning/end of biblical text. Red lettering is quite faint on many pages.

Eusebian canons in margin of biblical text.

1a–78a: Matthew 15.22–28.20. Short quire; the scribe finishes a quire with the end of the Gospel.

78b: blank page

79a: κεφαλαια for Mark.

79b: blank, but some residue from Mark's headpiece still there.

80a–137a: Mark (short quire).

136b: Mark 16.8

138ab: κεφαλαια for Luke.

138b: outline of heading for Luke, not filled in.

138b–201a: Luke³

164b: asterisk inside margin of biblical text.

202a–281b: John 1.1–21.8a

202a: Beautiful ornate headpiece for the commentary on John

230a: *pericope adulterae*
