Leather embossed wood boards; one male pin still intact.

First leaf is of a Christian (probably patristic) text, two columns, different hand.

Multiple scribes worked on MS.

MS is trapezoid: larger on inside than outside.

⁴ Leaf numbers: *actual* is listed first, then =, then the *written* number on the MS in single quotes. Thus: 214a = '212a.' Even though the quotation marks are used, there is no 'a' on the written page. For a MS that is paginated, the *actual leaf* number is listed first, followed by =, followed by the *page number* in quotes. Thus: 214a = '423.'
