Specific Details:

Wood boards covered with embossed leather, still intact.

NLG description (1892 catalog):

Psalms and biblical Odes, along with patristic interpretations by 18 different church fathers (Theodoret on the Psalms; Eusebius, Cyril of Alexander, Gregory of Nyssa, Seueros of Antioch, Chrysostom, Theodoret, Didymus, Nikolaos the Elder, Hesychius, Gennadius, Gregory the Theologian, Hypatius, Theodore (of Mopsuestia?), Eudoxios the Philosopher, Polychronios, Anepigraphos, Origen, Victor and Victor Patrikios on the Odes). *Nothing is mentioned about NT text.*

NT text is only on the last three leaves.

Slightly trapezoidal for some leaves (inside larger than outside).

Biblical text is sometimes in majuscule script and marked off with carats. Prayer of Zechariah and prayer of Symeon are in majuscule script.

Church fathers are mentioned in the margins next to their comments. Excellent help for readers since so many are quoted.

199b: Psalm of David is marked off in the margin with a large asterisk.

1–303a: Psalms and interpretation. Concludes with Ps 150.

303b: blank

304a–337b: Odes

337b–343a?: Prayer of the Three Youths

343b–344b: Prayer of Zechariah (Luke 2)

344b–345a: Prayer of Symeon (Luke 2)
