MS is trapezoid.

Well-worn text. Many wax drippings, somewhat fragile.

Rubricated musical notations [neuma] through much of the MS

End of quire is noted with rubricated notation at bottom right corner

Leaf 32r quire count is noted on first leaf of quire, not last leaf

Ornamentated headings at the beginning of a new book for lectionary reading purposes

Leaf 1v OT quotations marked with red round carat that at times looks like a big red dot

Leaf 1v contains Acts 4.23

Leaf 4r has stitch repair.

Leaf 4v has red maron lines 5-10, 24-27 (left column), 3-12 (right column)

Leaf 20 has top outer corner cut out.

Leaf 20r end of Acts and first Romans text

Leaf 29v correction in margin

Leaf 37r child's hand upside down in margin

Leaf 41v marginal correction

Leaf 46r 2Cor Arche

Leaf 51 Occasional prickings can be seen in margin

119v appears to be another hand.

120r has title material and ornamentation, has information about "September until December"

Starting at 120r begins a set of bioi and martyrdoms of various saints interspersed with lectionary readings from the apostolikon and paul.

Interesting writing by second hand on 143r.

157r small lectionary reading from Jeremiah
