Manuscript is held in a custom white foam board case which is enclosed in a grey envelope. Manuscript consists of two unattached leaves that are frayed around the edges but contain almost all of their original text. The front of the first leaf appears to have been burned and thus has suffered the most damage. All other pages are of good color. 1b contains a colorful epsilon ekthesis.

Both leaves, especially 1, have string sewn into the outer margins. On leaf 2 this survives only at the top. On leaf 1 it survives at the top and outer margin. However, on both pages holes for stitching can also be seen at the bottom and inner margin of the leaves.
