Additional matter: 4 images

Front cover: 0 additional leaves + cover b = 1 images

Back cover: 1 additional parchment leaf + cover a = 3 images

Spine, Cover, and Color Chart: 7 images (color chart on 2a)

Text: 548 leaves (1096 images)

UV (MS pages, not ours): additional parchment leaf before back cover (both sides)

Specific Details:

Wood boards covered with leather. Only half of front cover remains, covers in poor condition.

Trapezoid: outside larger than inside.

At least two different scribes. Perhaps the numbering of the quires was used only by the second scribe—hence the numbering doesn't begin until quire 16.

Lectionary for private use most likely.

195a: menologion begins.

353a–356b: largely blank with some later writing on 354b and 355b.

375b: blank
