leaf 1b: John 4.49b–52a

leaf 2a: John 6.27–32a

leaf 2b: John 6.32b–33; John 6.35–38a (all but last word, με)

leaf 3a: John 6.38b–39; 6.40–43a

leaf 3b: John 6.43b–44; John 6.48–52a

leaf 4a: John 6.52b–54; John 15.17–19a

leaf 4b: John 15.19b–25a

Previously owned by Mr. Lee Biondi, four leaves of this lectionary were auctioned off by Heritage Auction House in March 2008. Each leaf was purchased by a separate buyer. Mr. Bill Eubanks, of Fort Worth, TX, purchased one of the leaves. Dr. David L. Brown, of Oak Creek, WI purchased the leaf containing Mark 16:7b-8 and portions of John 4. The location of the other two leaves is unknown.

The text is approximately 24.75 cm tall by 18 cm wide. Each page has two columns, and each column has approximately 20 lines. The lectionary hand is inelegant, with many corrections especially by a later corrector. Accents are added in red.
