<sup>1</sup> That is, the manuscript was formerly misclassified as a minuscule; however, the manuscript is a lectionary. The spine on the cover says *πραχεις αποστολων*.

<sup>2</sup> First three leaves and last two leaves are in a different hand. Their texts are not part of the lectionary but are five leaves from the *Acts of Paul and Thecla*. The first leaf begins in chapter 1, in the middle of the description of Paul.
