Interesting or significant images:

Scribe didn't count the first quire, and numbers the quires on the last leaf of each quire.

Rebound with a recent cover. Foliated in pencil. Quires have been rebound with filler material and so the count for the quires is not exact throughout. Lapis lazuli, gold, rubrication, in 11<sup>th</sup> c. portion.

Normal to light wear and tear for a lectionary.

Ownership listed at 1r on top ("This belongs to the sinner Nikolaos of Βισυνης") in brackets after that circa 14c.

49r nice headpiece.

68r OT quotes with standard carats

Text in the shape of a cross on "121v"

122r begins a later hand

122r has nice headpiece.

14c. MS has rubrication only, no other colors besides the brown ink.

Textual corrections on 191r and 355r.

The reader apparently licked his fingers and pulled the pages across the MS from the upper-middle part of the page as he was reading. Normally, the page is pulled from the lower edge.

Chalk residue is still found on the pages of 14<sup>th</sup> c. MS; see 229r ff. for good examples.

320r Nikolaos βιζυησ is mentioned as the owner again.

322r starts the older hand again.

393r starts much later paper—c. 19<sup>th</sup> c.

last paper leaf on the verso says number "7030."
