Specific Details:

Modern cloth covers; MS has been recently trimmed, very uniform leaf sizes.

Elegant hand, rubricated, with many vivid colors. '

MS hardly touched until the last several leaves. Menologion is used extensively. The uneven wear seems to suggest that it was privately owned rather than used in divine service.

Beautiful headpieces, enlarged ekthesis initials, ornate letters with images, animals, decorations, etc.

1b: unfinished icon of John and Prochoros in the Cave of the Apocalypse.

2b: colophon including date

3ab: more writing

4a: blank

4b: icon of John and Prochoros in Cave of Apocalypse on Patmos

5a: Johannine prologue

123a: rare marginal correction, suggesting that this MS was for private use.

327a [328a]: Menologion begins, and with it we see significantly heavier use.

342a [341a]: marginal correction

The MS appears to be complete, in spite of the unknown quire count at beginning and one quire (30) inexplicably having an extra leaf.
