The manuscript is extremely fragile, with pages falling out. We recommend that this particular manuscript not be open to examination again; researchers should use just the photographs that we are providing. This MS was also difficult to shoot for other reasons: the inner margin had text that was buried in a tight binding, but by shooting at an angle we could dig some of it out.

some parchment is thick, some thin. rubrication in margins has been cut out in several places; replacement parchment has taken the place of the missing half leaves. some of the leaves are shredding from the stylus.
