Kamariotissis 74 (71); pencil: 70. (What the penciling in the catalog apparently means is that the new sn simply indicates that there are MSS missing. In other words, if the collection originally had 100 books but two were lost then the numbering would reflect this: the last numbered item would be 98. This is confusing for outsiders, however, since the numbering system changes every time a book goes missing.

242 leaves including all but the covers. Numbered leaf count is 240: this does not include the two extra leaves, one at front and one at back. File count will be +2. Total count should be 244 x 2.
