There are also four quires of blank leaves that have not been glazed. Each quire has between 4 and 10 leaves (Quire A). There is some parchment binding with lettering on it. In Quire A (10 leaves) the binding is still intact, even the threading in the middle. Quire B has 8 leaves. Quire C has 6 leaves. Quire D has 7 leaves.

The dimensions of each quire are as follows:

Quire  $A = 13.8 \text{ cm W} \times 17 \text{ cm H}$ 

Quire  $B = 13.7 \times 16.8$ 

Quire  $C = 13.8 \times 16.5$
