Specific Details:

Wood covered with embossed leather with male clasps still intact. Front cover is almost completely separated from codex.

Inside front cover is a parchment leaf from another MS, with only four lines of text on it. Does not appear to be biblical; no older than IX. Back inside cover is *another* text, probably patristic. Dealing with the resurrection of Lazarus.

Eusebian canons throughout, along with lectionary $\alpha p \chi \eta$ and $\tau \epsilon \lambda o \zeta$. Running $\kappa \epsilon \phi \dot{\alpha} \lambda \alpha \iota \alpha$ at bottom of pages.
