Ευαγγελιστάριον

Τα περιγαμηνά φύλλα είναι 13ου-14ου αι., τα χαρτώα 16ου-17ου. Λείπει η μπροστινή πινακίδα του κώδικα και έχει αντικατασταθεί από νεότερο χαρτόνι. Εξ αγοράς από Στέφανον Κουμανούδη (1987).

Trapezoid, with outside significantly smaller than inside.

Top of MS is cropped too closely, sometimes cutting off text.

Last pericope of front paper leaves: John 20.19ff.; first pericope of parchment: John 2.1ff. Thus, the paper leaves are intended to be replacements, since John 20.19ff. is read the first Sunday after Easter, and John 2.1ff. is read the first Monday after Easter week in the synaxarion.

41b: Binding strip between folios 41 and 42 has text on possibly 3 lines on the verso (end of letters; no full letters visible). One extra image in Additional Matter with this binding strip.

93 is paper replacement leaf with writing only in one half-width column and only on one side. Not the same as the other paper scribe. XVI–XVII probably. Mark 10.38–45, which picks up from the previous leaf.

130a—great illustration of a scribe working around the hole in the MS.
