Specific Details:

The majuscule requires MSI to uncover more letters. It is obviously a two-column MS, with the space between the columns running the length of the page. The top of the page, with a good-sized margin (c. 2.7–3.0 cm) is also visible. The inner margin is c. 2.0 cm wide.
