Other notable features: headings are in gold letters, though the gold lettering was added later. There is bleed-through, and more often, bleed *on* the opposite page, making the letters look a little blurry in the headings. That is, the gold letters were traced over earlier brown letters. Beautiful Eusebian canons with tissue protecting them. Between 89v and 90r, a page seems to have been cut out. Several marginal notes (rubricated) have been scratched out.
