Cover material: 10 front leaves plus front cover; 4a and 5a with Italian text, 6–10 with Eusebian apparatus and 6a with note from scribe. 3 back leaves plus back cover.

Text: foliated correctly up to leaf 13. Two leaves are foliated as 14 so leaf count is off by one; total leaves: 230

UV (MS pages, not ours): cover material, leaf “V”

Notable features:

Brown cardboard cover with gilded leaf edges.

¹ The Eusebian material constitutes a 7-leaf quire.

Three paper leaves begin and end the manuscript.
The start of each quire is numbered in the top right corner and the end of each quire at the end of each quire in the lower right corner.
Highly ornamented Eusebian canons with the letter to Carpian at the start of the manuscript.
The kephalaia of all four Gospels and the first page of Matthew are written in gold over red ink.
Ornamented headpieces and drop caps decorate the beginning of each Gospel.
Matthew begins on 1a.
Mark begins on 63a.
Luke begins on 105a.
John begins on 269a.
Long ending of Mark is on 102a–b.
Pericope Adulterae is on 186a–b.
