Specific Details:

Modern cloth binding, completely intact.

1a ('1')–93a ('184'): Matt 1.8–28.20

93b ('185')–94a ('186'): κεφάλαια for Mark

94b ('187'): Ornate text in Old Church Slavonic. Brief comment on the four Gospels.

Suggests a provenance (for at least when this MS traveled there) of Moldavia.

According to Filotheu Balan, it is a dedication belonging to Ieremia Movila, written on 21(?) Dec 1599 (7106). It may be a colophon which mentions the monastery of Vatoped.

95a ('188')–146b ('291'): Mark

95a ('188'): Ornate initial letter⁵

95a–: Second hand, beginning with Mark

128b: Text omitted added in margin

145b ('289'): Mark 16.8 (no markings)

147a ('292')–148b ('295'): κεφάλαια for Luke

149a ('296')–256a ('510'): Luke

165a ('328')ff.: Third hand?

192b ('383'): Text added in the margin (a different hand from the scribe who wrote Mark)

256b ('511'): Blank (no κεφάλαια)

257a ('512')–332b ('663'): John 1.1–21.3a

286a ('570')–287a ('572'): PA
