**Specific Details:**

MS appears to have been singed in *two* fires: leaves on front slightly singed, but burn holes through f. 33; the last few on the back are burned. Ff. '213–216' especially burnt.

Wood boards, with many termite holes in them (especially on front cover), covered by leather. Intact.

MS has wrap commentary on three sides, petite hand, extensive.

MS is slightly trapezoidal, ½ cm larger on inside vs. outside.

On 1a the years 1779 (May) and 1784 (April) are written in Arabic numbers.

1a–67a: Matthew

1a: headpiece for Matthew unfinished

67a: Matthew concludes in an inverted pyramid

67b: three columns in rubrication: *hypothesis* for Mark (1 col.), κεφάλαια for Mark (2 cols.).

68a–105b: Mark

68a: unfinished headpiece for Mark  
68a: Mark 1.2 has εν τω ησαια τω προφητη  
105a: Mark 16.8, with comment on bottom of page; very unusual looking γαρ.  
106a–175a: Luke  
106a: unfinished headpiece for Luke  
175b: *hypothesis* for John  
176a: κεφάλαια for John  
176b–217b: John (through 19.23)  
176b: unfinished headpiece for John  
**198a: John 7.52–8.12, with no PA.**
