Additional Matter: 18 images

Front (11 images): inside front cover, 2 loose paper leaves, 3 bound paper leaves

Back: (7 images): 3 bound paper leaves, inside back cover

¹ Note in second loose leaf in front as follows:
“Drew MS 6[:] Lectionary of Gospels
2nd half of the Xith century. Ekphonic notation in carmine ink.

Text: 247 leaves (494 images): foliated from front to back, bottom of recto; foliated upside down on verso from back of book forward.

‘42’ = 41 (off 1 until ‘51’)

‘51’ = 49 (off 2 through end of MS)

Cover & Color Chart (7 images): front, back, top, bottom, spine, edge

UV: No need for UV; doesn’t make text clearer.

Notable features:

Front inside cover: details of MS

First loose leaf: MS identification and date

Second loose leaf:

“Drew MS 6[:] Lectionary of Gospels

2nd half of the Xith century.

Ekphonic notation in pale carmine ink.

Nov. 20, 2003

Nadejhda Karrus-Hoffmann”

Looks like it may be a palimpsest. First indication is that it is numbered upside down on verso, beginning with the last leaf. Also, some evidence of undertext letters can be seen.

33b: beginning there is some kind of unfinished design

86b: petite hand single paragraph

87a: ornamentation

158a: ornamentation

213a: ornamentation

229b: note written in the margin in which the rust/mold does not touch it. This suggests that the rust/mold came *after* this note was added. The note is late, perhaps 16th century.

231a: marginal note at the end page
